Searching The Spectrum

To find The Spectrum on the Internet Archives:

- 1. Go to library.noctrl.edu
- 2. Click on Archives next to logo in middle of page
- 3. Click on Digital Collections "Explore digital content from . . . "
- 4. Click on The Spectrum

You have two options for searching through The Spectrum: browsing through a volume or searching a volume. You cannot easily search across volumes of The Spectrum.

To browse through a volume:

- 1. Click on the cover of the volume you wish to browse through
- 2. Turn pages by clicking on the far right page edge. To turn back a page, click on the far left page edge.
- 3. To move to fullscreen view, click the four-arrow icon on the far right at bottom of page above help button.
- 4. To move quickly to a particular page, move to fullscreen view, then drag the ball along the progress bar at the bottom of the page.

To search for a word or phrase within a volume:

- 1. Click on the cover of the volume you wish to search.
- 2. Click on the magnifying glass on the left under the Internet Archive to search within this issue.
- 3. Type your search term or phrase into the "search inside this book" box, then hit enter or click the magnifying glass.
- 4. If there are results for your search, yellow indicators will appear on the scroll bar below the yearbook image. Click on each indicator to move to the page. The search term will be highlighted on the page on which it appears.

To download material:

- 1. To download a PDF of the entire yearbook, click on the three dots on left side (under magnifying glass).
- 2. Click on arrow pointing down. Select "Get-.pdf"
- 3. To download a page of the yearbook, right-click on the page and select "save image as." The default image type is JPG.
